# LINA

Sweater w/lace pattern

Instruction: Olaug Beate Bjelland

## Sizes:

(S) M (L) XL (XXL)

## Measurements:

Bust: approx (87) 93 (101) 107 (113) cm

Length: (55) 56 (57) 58 (59) cm, or suitable length

Sleeve length: 8 cm, or suitable length

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension

## Yarn:

LINE (53 % cotton, 33 % viscose, 14 % linen, 50 g = 110 m)

## Yarn required:

Curry #2146: (7) 7 (8) 8 (9) balls

## Suggested knitting needles:

Circular and double pointed 3.5 mm

Crochet hook 3 mm

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.

## Tension:

20 sts pattern and St-st with 3.5 mm ndls = 10 cm

**Edge st: k every row**

## Front:

Work top from neck down. Upper part creates v-neck by inc of sts at each side of the 3 pattern repeats.

With 3.5 mm circular ndl cast on 11 sts and work as follows:

(first row = WS) 1 edge st, \*k1, work 3 sts in 1 st (= work alternately in front, back, front of loop), k1\*, rep from \*-\*, end with 1 edge st = 17 sts.

Insert marker between each pattern repeat (= 5 sts each repeat), and 1 edge st at each side. Cont **diagram** inside 1 edge st at each side, and inc as shown in diagram = 155 sts on ndl. Insert marker at each side of the middle pattern repeat = 51 sts between markers.

Cont St-st over all sts, inside 1 edge st at each side, **at the same time** inc 1 st at each side of markers = 4 sts inc.

(From now on do not inc at beg and end of row further in work).

Rep inc on alt rows a total of (18) 21 (25) 28 (31) times, **at the same time** on last row cast off edge st = (87) 93 (101) 107 (113) sts between markers and (69) 72 (76) 79 (82) sts at each

Transfer sts to 3 extra threads, the middle (87) 93 (101) 107 (113) sts is later worked tog with sts for the back to full length during the finishing process.

Put front aside and work the back.

## Back:

Cast on and work in the same manner as front, but work St-st without pattern, and with inc as for front.

## Finishing:

Sew shoulder seams.

## Sleeves:

Transfer (32) 34 (36) 38 (40) sts at each side of shoulder seam to small 3.5 mm circular ndl = (64) 68 (72) 76 (80) sts.

Join and work 2 cm St-st in rnds.

Insert marker at underarm of sleeve and dec 1 st at each side of marker as follows: k2tog tbl after marker and k2tog before marker.

Rep dec every 1,5 cm a total of 3 times = (58) 62 (66) 70 (74) sts.

Cont until sleeve meas 8 cm, or suitable length.

Cast off loosely.

Work other sleeve in the same manner.

## Work back and front tog at sides:

Transfer (37) 38 (40) 41 (42) sts for front and back to 2 separate ndls, and with RS facing work 1 st from each part tog on WS, **at the same time** cast off loosely.

## Back and front:


Transfer rem sts to 3.5 mm circular ndl = (174) 186 (202) 214 (226) sts.

Join and cont St-st in rnds until work meas (54) 55 (56) 57 (58) cm from shoulder, or until 1 cm before suitable length.

Then p 1 rnd, \*k 1 rnd, p 1 rnd\*, rep \*-\* once more.

Cast off loosely k-wise.

With 3 mm crochet hook work 1 row sc at neck edge.

- p on RS, k on WS
- Inc 1 st = k 1 in back of loop, k 1 in front of loop
- Inc 1 st = k 1 in front of loop, k 1 in back of loop
- 1 yo
- sl 1 k-wise, k2tog, pssso
- k2tog
- sl 1, k1, pssso
